Unused Vacation After *Roseland*.

Pay Up ?

On October 20th the Nebraska Supreme Court held in *Roseland v. Strategic Staff Management* that accrued vacation time is due and payable as wages upon termination of employment, even if the employer's handbook provides otherwise. This decision may also impact "use it or lose it" vacation policies and require payment of other benefits upon separation, such as sick leave, personal leave, and PTO. Nebraska employers need to understand the *Roseland* case, determine whether their current policies might run afoul of the court's ruling, and if so, consider revisions to reduce exposure.
